For most adults, technology is something new and therefore they feel overwhelmed when it comes to supporting their children in school assignments on digital devices. Educov project were created in order to support parents and teachers during online teaching. The COVID-19 pandemic has forced us to make a remarkable digital breakthrough in our children's primary education that requires significant adjustments not only for children and their teachers but also for parents.
